



## The UK Youth Fund – Terms and Conditions

By completing the UK Youth Fund – Covid Relief Questionnaire eligible organisations will also be also be making a grant application to UK Youth Fund - Covid Relief. By submitting this questionnaire, you agree and confirm that:

1. You are authorised to apply for this grant on behalf of your organisation and that all the information you provide to us is accurate and correct.
2. Any grant awarded by us to you will be used solely for the purposes set out in your application.
3. If your application is successful, we will make a grant offer to you on Monday 14<sup>th</sup> December 2020. You must accept the grant offer by returning a signed grant agreement form by 5pm Wednesday 16<sup>th</sup> December 2020.
4. You must promptly repay any money incorrectly paid to you by us, either as a result of administrative error or otherwise.
5. Your involvement in the project and your receipt of the grant may be publicly acknowledged without prior notice to you.
6. Should you receive a grant but fail to spend it as you have proposed we may ask you to repay the grant.
7. You are happy to complete short online reporting forms throughout the length of the grant, which will be provided to all successful organisations. As part of our grant monitoring process and as a Commitment to Celebrate, UK Youth may visit your organisation, where safe and appropriate, to capture stories that can be shared demonstrating the impact of the funding.
8. You have the appropriate processes and policies in place to keep young people safe. This must include a Safeguarding and Health & Safety Policy. We may ask to see this if you are awarded funding.
9. You have the appropriate insurances, qualifications, or affiliations to a governing body. Depending on what you want to do this could include public liability insurance, leaders or instructors with special qualifications or an affiliation to a governing body. We may ask to see these if you are awarded funding.
10. You comply with the Equality Act 2010, the General Data Protection Regulation 2018 and Data Protection Act 2018, Public Services (Social Value) Act 2012 and all other relevant statutory or regulatory requirements.
